Priorities

- Support improvements in Public Health Infrastructure
 - o Ability to recruit and retain qualified staff
 - o Address statewide cybersecurity, and Georgia/Local Public Health IT Systems upgrades
 - o Support continued infectious disease response
 - o Support construction of S. Cobb Public Health Center
- Improve access to quality prenatal care, perinatal mental health services and family support
- Improve access to prevention, treatment and recovery services and a multiagency approach to combat the opioid crisis
- Improve access to prevention, diagnosis and treatment of sexually transmitted infections including HIV through public health and other medical providers
- Expanded access to all public health services, including
 - o Women, Infant and Children (WIC) Nutrition
 - o Healthy Start pre/postnatal support services
 - o Family Planning
 - o Environmental Health, particularly restaurant, lead, and body arts regulation
 - o Services for children with special needs
 - o Immunizations
